## Workshop/Class Descriptions

<p><b>September 17, 2015</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Special Needs Trust and ABLE Act</b></p> <p>Both are ways to build a “pot of gold” for your child in the future. How are they alike? How are they different? Do you need one or both or neither?</p>
<p><b>October 22, 2015</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Supplemental Security Income, otherwise known as SSI</b></p> <p>Is there really this much paperwork involved? How do you navigate the red tape to get financial assistance for your child to add to their “pot of gold”? Also, IDEA, IEP, SSI, DSPD, etc. - What do all of those letters mean? Deciphering the code.</p>
<p><b>November 19, 2015</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Support Coordination and Person Centered Planning/ Life Planning</b></p> <p>Do you know how to select a Support Coordinator and what can you expect from him or her? Do you need a person centered or life plan for your son or daughter? Whether you receive DSPD funding or not, a life plan will guide you through the life span of your child to make sure his or her needs are met.</p>
<p><b>January 21, 2016</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Benefit and Employment Planning</b></p> <p>Your son receives SSI but wants to work - How can he get a job and not lose benefits? Your daughter doesn't fit the mold of a “typical” employee? Discover creative work opportunities.</p>
<p><b>February 18, 2016</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Dual Diagnosis</b></p> <p>When your child has symptoms of both intellectual or developmental disabilities and a mental health diagnosis, what do you do? Or simply stated: “My kid's behavior looks like whaaaat?” Help is available to address BOTH diagnoses.</p>
<p><b>March 17, 2016</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Housing Options and Opportunities</b></p> <p>How to find the “pot of gold” when you look at housing for your child with special needs.</p>
<p><b>April 21, 2016</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Division of Services for People With Disabilities (DSPD) Services</b></p> <p>What is this state agency and what can they provide me? How to navigate the maze of waiting lists and documentation - What is at the “end of the rainbow?”</p>
<p><b>May 19, 2016</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Related Services and Summer Activities</b></p> <p>How to “just keep swimming, just keep swimming” during the summer so your child continues to progress and reach goals.</p>
