





How to Download the 'Beep Tapes' to Your Computer

1. Right click (control+click for Macs) on the file you want and choose: 'Save Link As...'
2. Select where you want to save it, name it, and click save.
3. Locate the file on your computer, open, and enjoy.
4. This can now be burned to a CD for your CD player if you'd like (for help, ask your school tech)
