- ✓ Academic work on appropriate level for student
- ✓ Adequate academic support, teaching, and review
- ✓ Explicit instruction for all subjects

## Replacement Behavior: Self-Regulation

DO!		DON'T!
<b>1.</b>	Use 'planned ignoring' (ignore talk-outs, noises, etc.).	Don't give warnings.  Don't give attention.
<b>2.</b>	Reinforce for on-task and compliance (point card on desk).	
<b>3.</b>	Teach appropriate classroom behaviors (listening, on-task).	
<b>4.</b>	Use group contingencies (whole group earns rewards or individual student earns something for group).	
<b>5.</b>	Use Response Cost Tickets. ➤ <i>See: Sample Response Cost Tickets</i>
