Written Prior Notice (WPN)

Written Prior Notice requirements are located in SPECIAL ED RULES. **WPN** must be given a **REASONABLE** amount of time **BEFORE**:

PLACEMENT, EVALUATION, ELIGIBILITY, AND REFUSAL

WPN includes a description of action proposed or refused and why, a copy of Procedural **SAFEGUARDS**, description of all information and **OPTIONS** considered, and **WRITTEN** evidence. WPN is provided in parent's **NATIVE** language.

Don't forget to **take IEP Meeting notes** to **DOCUMENT** parent requests and to **save copies** of IEP **DRAFTS**.



New Rules/SLD Changes

SLD eligibility requirements have **CHANGED**! Please follow the *Special Education* **RULES** for Specific Learning Disabilities on pages **43-48**. Although a discrepancy report is still **REQUIRED**, the 93 percent confidence is no longer **NECESSARY**. Instead, "the team must **DOCUMENT** consideration of the **DISCREPENCY** report and the team's determination of whether or not it **REPRESENTS** a significant discrepancy."

SCRAM 102 & Medicaid Consent

Submit a new SCRAM **DOCUMENT** after an IEP or change in services. Fill the SCRAM form out **COMPLETELY**. New this year: **SHORT- TERM** Home/Hospital is **NOT** a change in placement, so **DON'T**change SCRAM. Refer to SCRAM **102** on SpEd Web site for detailed information (Staff > **FORMS**).

We must have **ONE-TIME** written parent consent in order to seek Medicaid **REIMBURSEMENT.** Return all **SIGNED** parental consent forms to the JSD **HEALTH SERVICES** Department, at Kauri Sue Hamilton School.

Private School, Home School and Dual Enrollment

ALWAYS call <u>**IULIE BROWN- 801-567-8200</u>** for information on private and homeschool students.</u>

The district is ALWAYS responsible for **CHILD FIND.**

Do private school students who receive the Carson Smith Scholarship receive special education services? ANSWER: **No**

Private and homeschooled students receive services on an **INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICE PLAN** or **ISP** (acronym).

Dynamic Learning Maps and Essential Elements

Replaces the Utah Alternate Assessment and Extended Core Standards

The Essential Elements (EE) link to **THE UTAH CORE STANDARDS.**

The <u>DYNAMIC LEARNING MAPS</u> (DLM) will allow students with significant cognitive disabilities to "show what they know" and track their progress.

EE and DLM are part of a 16 state collaboration that is creating **NEW IDEAS** and **NEW CURRICULUM**.

Elementary/Pre-K Transition (Elem./Pre-K Only)

What was sent to your administrator by email? **YEAR END REPORTS - DOT EARLY CHILDHOOD OBSERVATION TOOL**

Another SCRAM must be submitted again when the student turns <u>6 YEARS OLD</u> and the 'Environmental Code' must be changed.

Students classified as Developmentally Delayed (DD) must be **RECLASSIFIED PRIOR TO THEIR 8**TH Birthday (regardless of the 3 year re-evaluation due date).

Secondary Transition (Secondary Only)

The ongoing process of collecting **DATA** on the individual's **NEEDS**, preferences, and **INTERESTS** as they are related to the demands of current and future **WORKING**, **EDUCATIONAL**, **LIVING** and personal and **SOCIAL** environments.

The 4 pathways Jordan District Considers for all students beginning in 9th grade are: <u>ACADEMIC POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION, CAREER-TECHNICAL EDUCATION TRAINING, EMPLOYMENT, COMMUNITY AND LIFE SKILLS - INDEPENDENCE</u>

What three things MUST be included on the Notice of Meeting for transition when a student is 18? 1) PURPOSE OF MEETING GOALS AND TRANSITION, 2) LEA WILL INVITE STUDENT, 3) IDENTIFY ANY AGENCY INVITED.

Child Find & LRE

A change in placement is an **IEP TEAM** decision.

What MUST be included for each critical concern noted in your LRE packet? **TARGETED INTERVENTION DATA**

The district has child find responsibilities that are triggered when it **HAS REASON TO SUSPECT** that a student has a **DISABILITY** and may need special education services.
