This form must be completed for each instance that **physical restraint** is used and submitted to Brian King at River's Edge School.

Because **physical restraint** falls under the category of Emergency Safety Intervention (ESI) it should only be used when a student presents an immediate danger to himself/herself or others and it is not for disciplinary purpose.

**Physical restraint** means restriction that immobilizes or reduces the ability of an individual to move freely. A restraint must be of the shortest duration, and carried out with the least amount of force, necessary to de-escalate the emergency situation and ensure the safety of the student and others.

**Immediate danger** means the danger of physical violence/aggression toward oneself or others that is likely to cause serious physical harm. This type of intervention is considered highly intrusive and shall only be used in emergency situations, they should not be used as punishment or for any non-dangerous or non-emergency reasons, such as noncompliance, disrespect, disobedience, misuse or destruction or property, or disruption.
