Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and Utah State Special Education Graduation Guidelines indicate that a student's eligibility for a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) terminates when a student reaches maximum age for eligibility.

In Utah, a student reaches maximum age at 22 years old. If a student with a disability turns 22 during the school year the entitlement extends to the end of the year.

Utah Code 53E-7-202

Your son/daughter will no longer be eligible for special education services through Jordan School District. The last day of school for your child is _____.

We anticipate that in compliance with state graduation guidelines, your son/daughter will receive a certificate of completion rather than a regular high school diploma.

Your son/daughter will receive an Exit Summary of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance. This document can be shared with adult agencies.
