Determination of a State's Implementation of IDEA

- Four levels of **Determination** 
  - · Meets Requirements
  - Needs Assistance
  - Needs Intervention
  - Needs Substantial Intervention
- Determination is based on 17 Indicators
  - 35 Targets

#### Annual Determination

- OSEP gives all states and territories an annual Determination
  - Posted on the OSEP's website

<u>State Performance Plans (SPP) Letters and Annual Performance Report (APR) Letters - Individuals with Disabilities Education Act</u>

- Utah (USBE) gives all LEAs an annual Determination
  - Posted on the USBE website

### Utah's Determination

- Utah is in Meets Requirements for the first year
   Prior to this year, Utah was in Needs Assistance for 6 straight years
- In February of 2021, Utah either met or was in significant compliance with 11 of 25 targets on the applicable indicators (10 targets were not reported because statewide assessments were suspended due to COVID-19)
- In February of 2020, Utah met or was in significant compliance with 14 of 35 targets
